

Think about a famous person from history or modern times that you know a lot of facts and information about...

How much info could you list about that person in 2 minutes?

Isn't it amazing that we can know <u>so much</u> about someone that we have never actually met before?

The same can be true of God in our lives: we can know all about Him – lots of facts – all kinds of information – but not know Him personally, for ourselves.

#### I know Albert Einstein was real:

- \* I believe he was real.
- \* I believe that the info I know about him is true.
- But I didn't KNOW him; I've had no personal acquaintance with him.
- \* I don't know him AND he doesn't know me.
- \* He is real but he is distant and we don't know each other.

Abram, Moses, Saul – they all had this same experience at first:

- \* They knew God was real.
- \* They genuinely believed in God.
- \* They believed the information they knew about God was true.
- \* From our first introductions to these people, we can see that they even loved God, and that they wanted please God with their lives...
- \* But their knowledge of God, at least at first, was not personal.
- \* Their knowledge of God and their desire to please Him was distant and impersonal.

**Then, for each of them** – and many, many more people in the Bible and throughout history – things drastically changed when this real-but-distant God became close, personal, 1-1 known to them:

**Abram** – Genesis 11:27-12:9 **Moses** – Exodus 2:11-3:12 **Saul** – Acts 8:1, 9:1-19

## #1-God is Knowable

God has made Himself known to humanity. This is called "revelation". God has **revealed** Himself to mankind. He didn't have to do this. He could have remained distant & hidden from us. But He **chose** to show Himself to us! How has God revealed Himself to humanity?

### There are **2** primary ways:

- **1 through JESUS.** See Colossians 1:15,19; Colossians 2:9; John 10:30; John 14:9-10; Hebrews 1:1-3.
- **2– through the BIBLE.** See 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 1 Corinthians 2:10-13; Hebrews 4:12; 2 Peter 1:20-21.

God's personality & character & commands are all clearly described in the Holy Bible, and these were perfectly demonstrated through the life, teachings, and example of Jesus.

#### Other ways God reveals Himself to us:

- \* through creation (Job 26:7-14; Psalm 8:3-4; Psalm 19:1-4a; Romans 1:20)
- \* through other Christians who know and live according to God's Word (Proverbs 1:5; Prov. 12:15; Prov. 15:22; Prov. 19:20)
- \* through the poor and marginalized (Matthew 25:31-46)
- \* through our own circumstances (Genesis 50:20; Psalm 37:4; Psalm 90:17; Psalm 143:10; Proverbs 3:5-6; Proverbs 16:3; Acts 16:6-8; 1 Thessalonians 2:17b-18)
- \* through angels, dreams, & visions (Gen. 16:7-12; Exodus 3:2-4; Matt. 1:20-24; Matt. 2:13-21; Matt. 28:5-8; Luke 1:11-38; Luke 2:8-15; Acts 8:26-30; Acts 10:3-19; Revelation 1:1)

These other forms of revelation are valid, BUT they are all **secondary**. We should always check all of these other ways against the 2 primary ways that God reveals Himself to us: through Jesus & the Bible.

<u>Verses on Knowing GOD</u>: 1 Samuel 3:1-10; Deuteronomy 4:29; Jeremiah 29:12-14a; Jeremiah 33:3; Matthew 7:7-8; John 10:2-4,14; Isaiah 30:21.

# #2-God Knows You, personally—

You are not distant and unknown to God; You are known to Him, both personally and individually.

See Psalm 139:1-6,13-18 and Matthew 10:29-31.

## #3-Get to Know GOD NOW, while you are young

**Don't wait** until you are an adult to get to know God personally, for yourself. **Don't wait** until you are an adult to become a passionate & fully-devoted follower of Jesus!

#### You don't have to wait!

- \* David was about 15! 1 Samuel 13:13-14
- \* Joseph was 17! Genesis 39-41
- \* Jeremiah was a teenager! Jeremiah 1
- \* Timothy was a teenager! 1 Timothy 4:12
- \* The boy who shared his lunch so Jesus could feed the 5,000 was about 8! John 6:8-11
- \* Samuel was about 10! 1 Samuel 3:1-10
- \* Mary was about 14 Luke 1:26-38
- Jesus' first 4 disciples (Peter, Andrew, James, & John)
   were probably in their late teenage years! –
   Matthew 4:18-22
